



FAN BEHAVIOR POLICY

The goal of the Independent Interscholastic Athletic Association of Guam (IIAAG) is to promote and direct wholesome, sportsman-like competition that builds individual and team character and strengthens relationships among the local high schools. To achieve this goal, the league has set forth the following Fan Behavior Policy, to be adhered to at all IIAAG sanctioned competitions/events:

1. Spectators and anyone in attendance at IIAAG sanctioned events must comply with requests made by school administrators, athletic directors, site managers, student volunteers, game officials, medical personnel, security/police and league officials. Failure to do so may result in the immediate removal from the premises.
2. Parents and adult fans are expected to demonstrate leadership and model behavior at all times – before, during and after – while at competition sites for IIAAG events. Therefore, the following will not be tolerated:
 - Taunting, excessive and/or vulgar or negative cheering, confrontation with referees, opposing players, coaches and/or parents.
 - Negative or vulgar signs, banners or pictures
 - Public confrontation with coaches or players (Parents are encouraged to meet with the coach or school administrator privately to address any issues that may be of concern)
 - The use of profanity towards a player, coach, referee, administrator, athletic director, site manager, student volunteers or other parent/guest.
 - Threatening remarks to anyone in attendance at IIAAG events. Such remarks and/or action may result in the assistance of the local law enforcement.
3. Spectators are not permitted to enter the playing area (field, court, track, etc) at any time for any reason unless called in by the officials. Doing so may result in the immediate removal of the individual or individuals and may result in sanctions by the school and/or the IIAAG.

Failure to comply with the IIAAG's Fan Behavior Policy will be subject to sanctions including, but not limited to, suspension of privileges associated with attendance at events, immediate removal from a competition site, and/or a ban from future IIAAG competitions or competition sites, for a duration that the league sees fit, in relation to the offense.
